THE NEW MEXICO DIETETIC ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FACT SHEET

1. **Stipend:**

Scholarships are available in the amount of \$500.00. Scholarships are granted by The New Mexico Dietetic Association with selection of recipients by the NMDA Scholarship Committee.

2. **Qualifications for the Undergraduate Scholarship:**

-Applicant must be a student officially admitted to a nutrition/dietetics program at a New Mexico school who has completed a minimum of 60 credit hours including 12 hours applicable toward meeting the academic requirements for membership in the American Dietetic Association

- Applicant will be enrolled as an undergraduate next year
- GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Be a student member of the American Dietetic Association

3. **Qualifications for the Graduate Scholarship:**

-Applicant shall have applied to and been officially admitted or currently attending a graduate program or Internship in the next program year at a New Mexico school

- Applicant will be a resident of New Mexico
- GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Be a student member of the American Dietetic Association

4. **Complete application packet will include:**

- Completed Application form
- Two (2) letters of recommendation
